Final preparations for final presentation

This is how the presentations will unfold:

- 1. The first 20 minutes will be you and your family together
- 2. The second 20 minutes will be other families roaming through the room. If you are willing to share your work with other families, put a sticker on your computer signaling that you welcome visitors!
- 3. The final 20 minutes will be a wrap-up with your teacher with closing remarks.

Things to think about when preparing your presentation:

- Give a brief introduction so that your audience knows the direction of your presentation.
- What did you make? What did you learn?
- Talk about what was most important/interesting/surprising to you!
- How does what you learned about genetics and genealogy connect to what your sharing right now?
- Tell a story.
- Ask questions, and invite questions.
